11th House of Delegates District Democratic Committee to Determine the Method of Nomination for Democratic Candidate

FAIRFAX, VA – The 11th House of Delegates District Democratic Committee acknowledges the announcement of a special election on **January 13th, 2026** to fill the vacancy in the 11th District left by David Bulova, who has been nominated for the office of Virginia Secretary of Natural & Historic Resources by Governor-Elect Abigail Spanberger. The method of nomination for the Democratic candidate will be determined by the Committee, comprised of Susan Weltz from Fairfax County and Penny Rood from the City of Fairfax, in a special meeting this evening at 7:00pm over Zoom.

"The 11th District Committee is preparing to hold an unassembled caucus, also known as a 'firehouse primary' on Tuesday, December 16th," said Susan Weltz, Chair of the 11th District. "We look forward to an informative campaign that will give voters in the district a chance to vote for whom they wish to see representing them in the General Assembly, and then we must all unite in support of eventual Democratic nominee, whoever it may be."

A firehouse primary is a primary election run by a political party committee, not the state. Once determined by the 11th House of Delegates District Committee, the details of the firehouse primary will be published in a Call to Caucus and advertised to voters.

The meeting will be followed immediately by a press briefing, which will be followed by an additional Q&A for candidates or candidates representatives that will be closed to press.
